Flying into Your Mountain Home

Your trip to Purcell Mountain Lodge begins with a scenic helicopter ride!



Our helicopter provided has new guidelines implemented by Transport Canada. Guests are asked to please adhere to the new measures and plan accordingly.

- Upon arrival at Alpine Helicopters, you will be asked to wash your hands, put on your mask and read and sign a COVID-19 operational compliance before proceeding to the check in desk.

Masks are required to be worn by Purcell Mountain Lodge staff and guests inside the Alpine Helicopter facility.

Masks are required to be worn during the flight. If you do not have a mask, Alpine Helicopters will provide you with one.

Please physical distance two meters apart and no more than 15 people are permitted to be inside the building at one time.


Revamped Meal Service
