As we head towards summer, our dedicated ACMG hiking guides will be ready to showcase North America's largest alpine meadows. Our professionally guided hiking tours will be limited to a mixed group of no more than 14-18 guided and catered guests per tour. The private chalet will be limited to no more than 6-8 self guided and self catered guests for private groups. Small tour numbers will help ensure physical distancing measures. We want our guests and staff to feel comfortable interacting with each other.

Your daytime trip in the backcountry will be an incredible backcountry hiking experience and plenty of fresh mountain air. Back at the lodge guests can relax in the living room, dining room and library. Our new normal will include seating capacity signs posted in each common area as part of our COVID-19 Safety Plan.
