On November 19, the Provincial Health Officer issued a new province wide restriction to all individuals, places of work and businesses in B.C. to significantly reduce their level of social interaction and travel. Travel advisory at this time means all non-essential travel should be avoided. This includes travel in and out of B.C. and between regions of the province. Now is not the time to

travel to visit friends or family outside of your household or core bubble. If you need to travel for essential reasons such as work, please take the same health and safety precautions you do at home.

B.C. remains in Phase 3 of the restart plan and ski resorts are open. Please continue to enjoy skiing and snowboarding at your local mountains.



If you are coming from outside of B.C. at this time, people travelling to B.C. from another province or territory within Canada should only come to B.C. for essential reasons.

Keep dreaming of Purcell Mountain Lodge and plan your winter trip when the time is right. A good reference is to review the recommendations in British Columbia's restart plan. Follow the guidelines to protect travellers and residents. Most important, plan ahead and know before you go and remember to bring your own personal protective equipment such as masks and hand sanitizer.

The province wide restriction will remain in effect from November 19 until at least December 7

Thank you to many, many hero's on the frontlines of the Coronavirus fight!




